ASSISTANT CHIEF ENGINEER

Key responsibilities:

Supports the Director of Engineering in managing the resort's daily engineering operations and ensuring that all facilities, equipment, buildings, utilities, and grounds remain safe and in excellent condition. The role supervises the engineering team, coordinates daily maintenance activities, and oversees the operation and maintenance of power generation, desalination, sewage treatment, pumping, HVAC, electrical, plumbing, swimming pool, marine, and resort transportation systems. Key duties include managing preventive maintenance schedules, work orders, inspections, technical records, engineering projects, renovations, new installations, and equipment overhauls. The position is also responsible for diagnosing technical problems, ensuring repairs are completed safely and on time, monitoring the use of energy, water, fuel, spare parts, and materials, and maintaining accurate logs, reports, and inventories. The role also involves training and guiding the engineering team, coordinating maintenance needs with other departments, and taking responsibility for the Engineering Department in the absence of the Director of Engineering.

Requirements:

- Diploma or degree in Electrical, Mechanical, Marine, or a related engineering field
- Minimum 5 years of engineering or maintenance experience, including at least 2 years in a supervisory role
- Previous experience in a resort, hotel, or remote-island environment is preferred
- Strong working knowledge of power generation, desalination plants, sewage treatment plants, pumping systems, HVAC, plumbing, electrical systems, swimming pool systems, marine engines, and resort transportation
- Good knowledge of preventive maintenance planning, work-order systems, equipment records, and spare-parts inventory
- Strong leadership skills with the ability to supervise, guide, and develop the engineering team
- Able to diagnose technical problems and arrange safe and timely solutions
- Good understanding of workplace safety, fire safety, emergency procedures, and environmental practices
- Able to work independently, manage priorities, and remain calm during emergencies
